Charge Capture, a Clinical Xpert™ Navigator Module from the Healthcare business of Thomson Reuters, enables physicians to record procedure and diagnosis codes at the point of care and integrates these codes with patient-specific information relevant to each hospital encounter. Codes and applicable billing data are then quickly and easily transmitted back to the practice by the physician for improved revenue capture.

OVERVIEW

Charge Capture automatically integrates patient information from the Hospital Information System (HIS), removing the need for patient data entry during the charge-capture process. This mobile application gets smarter with the entire practice's use, remembering charge-diagnosis pairings and presenting the most frequently captured E&M and procedural codes to help streamline charge capturing for all users within a practice.

Charge Capture is fully integrated into Clinical Xpert Navigator, incorporating the same intuitive navigation and ease-of-use design philosophy.

HOW IT WORKS

Demographics and other relevant data about the patient are automatically delivered to the mobile device—eliminating redundant data entry. Charges are recorded by the physician as consults occur. After a user-initiated synchronization, encrypted charge data is sent to a secure (SSL) Web portal accessible by the practice business manager who can easily upload the charge information into the practice's system for complete, timely, and accurate billing.

- Diagnoses ranking provides users with the ability to prioritize diagnoses for optimal reimbursement.
- Application gets smarter with use by remembering charge-diagnosis pairings.
- Customizable electronic version of a practice's super bill to easily find frequently used codes.

- Charge and diagnosis codes are integrated with patient demographic and insurance data.
- Charges can be imported into a billing system via a secure Web portal.
